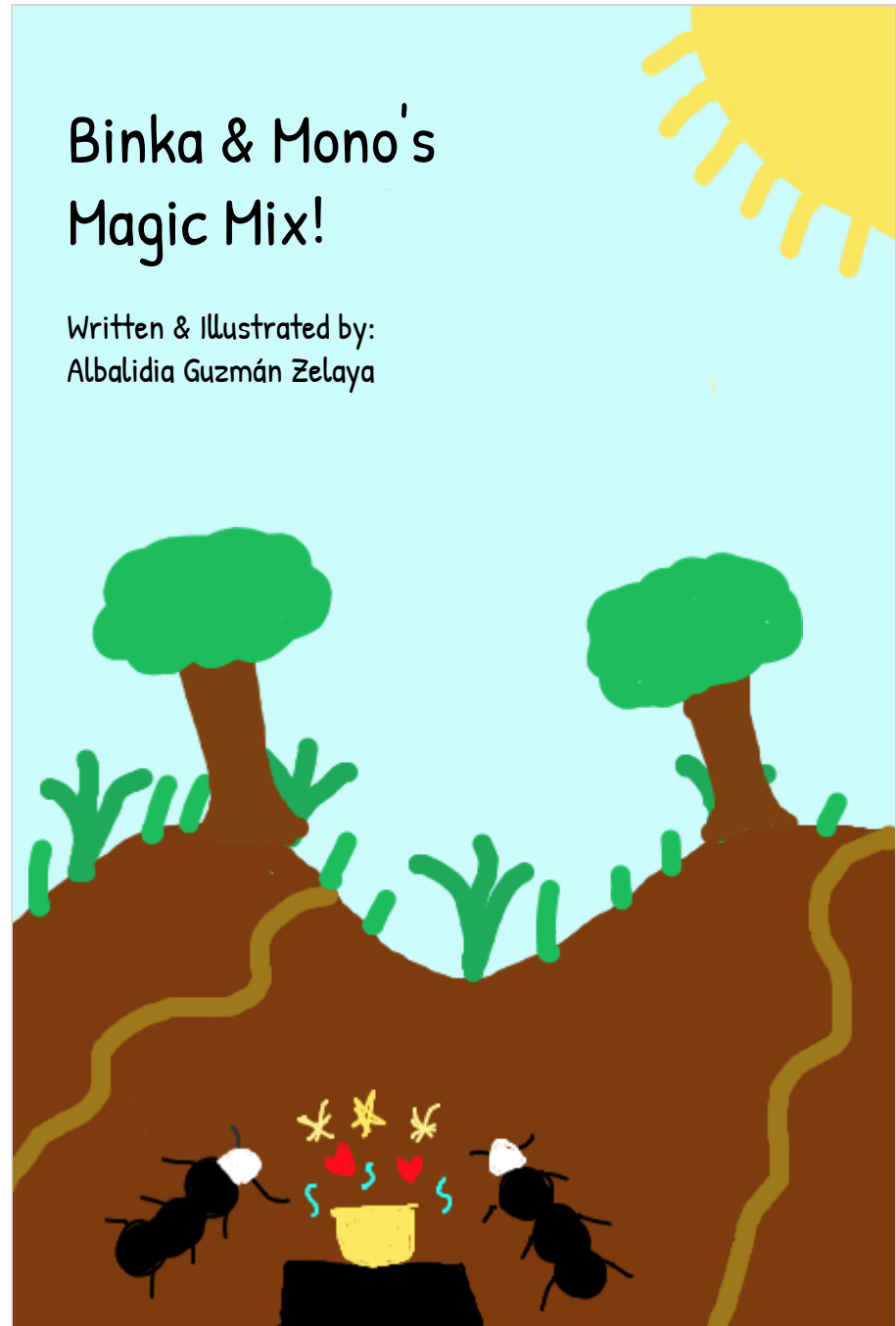



Binka & Mono's Magic Mix!
