Field
Hockey





Faced with the challenges of no practice field, all away games, and a majority of new and inexperienced players, Coach Bonnie Schreck put together a team that never quit.

After a losing season, suffering many close defeats, the team entered the State College Tournament as the underdog, but due to determination they beat Framingham State and lost to first place Worcester State by only one goal, giving the team a third place berth.

Cross Country



The Salem State cross country team, captained by Brian Gleason, had a winning season this year with 7 wins and 4 losses. The team is assured of at least three more good years as long as Mike Malloy, a freshman this year, continues to run.

With the first five men counting in cross country, Malloy constantly held the number one position all year, while the other runners, Brian Gleason, Terry Quinn, Bobby Cossman and Bob Wheeler, traded positions at every meet.

One of the best meets of the year for the team was here at home, where the meets are run at Marblehead Neck. Pitted against Lowell State, SSC won a resounding victory, winning places one through five in that race.

Since there are no senior members on the team, Coach Gillis is looking forward to another fine season.

Basketball

With a 12-3 league record, which won the Massachusetts State College Championship, and a 16-5 overall record, which led the team to the NAIA Tournament, Salem State's basketball team had a highly successful year.

Much of the success was due to junior center Etson Cameron who led in scoring with a 15.7 points per game, and rebounding with 11 rebounds per game. He was elected to the NAIA All District 32 South Basketball Team, and Coach Joe Lavacchia was elected Coach of the Year by the same district.

The outstanding play of seniors, All East forward, co-captain Bob Palange, forward, Kim Carpentier, and guard, Bob Burns will be missed next year, although next year should prove just as successful with many returning talents.

Basketball







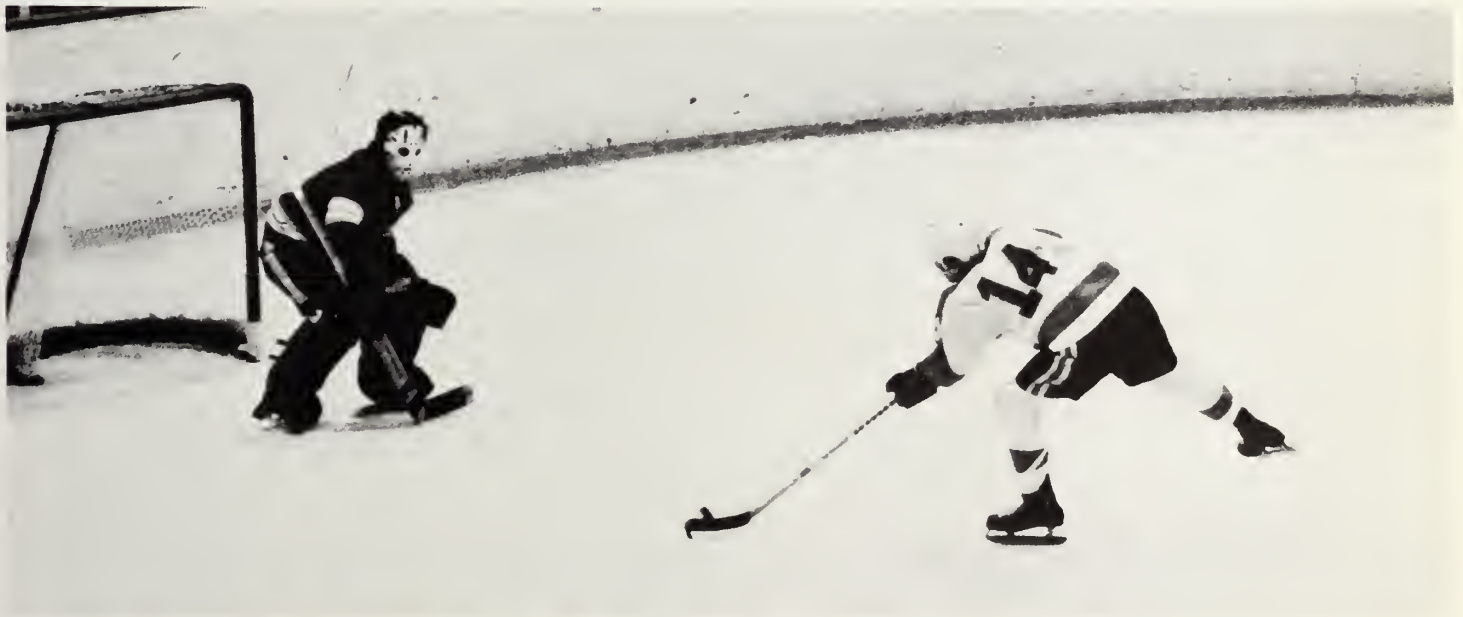

This year the freshmen stood out on the team with two time All East Defenseman, Dick Lamby, who this year made the first team of the All American ECAC Division II team. The goal tending was shared by freshmen Jerry Kusy and Gerry Gagnon.

The high-scoring ability of juniors Mark Boudreau and George Hughes, and senior John Griffin led Salem to a third place berth in Division II, losing in the semifinals to Merrimac College.

With the experience of tournament play, which was lacking this year, and a large number of returning players, as only two seniors, Jay O'Leary and John Griffin, are leaving, the team should win the division next year. Coach Urbanski and Assistant Coach Funchion are looking forward to a championship team.

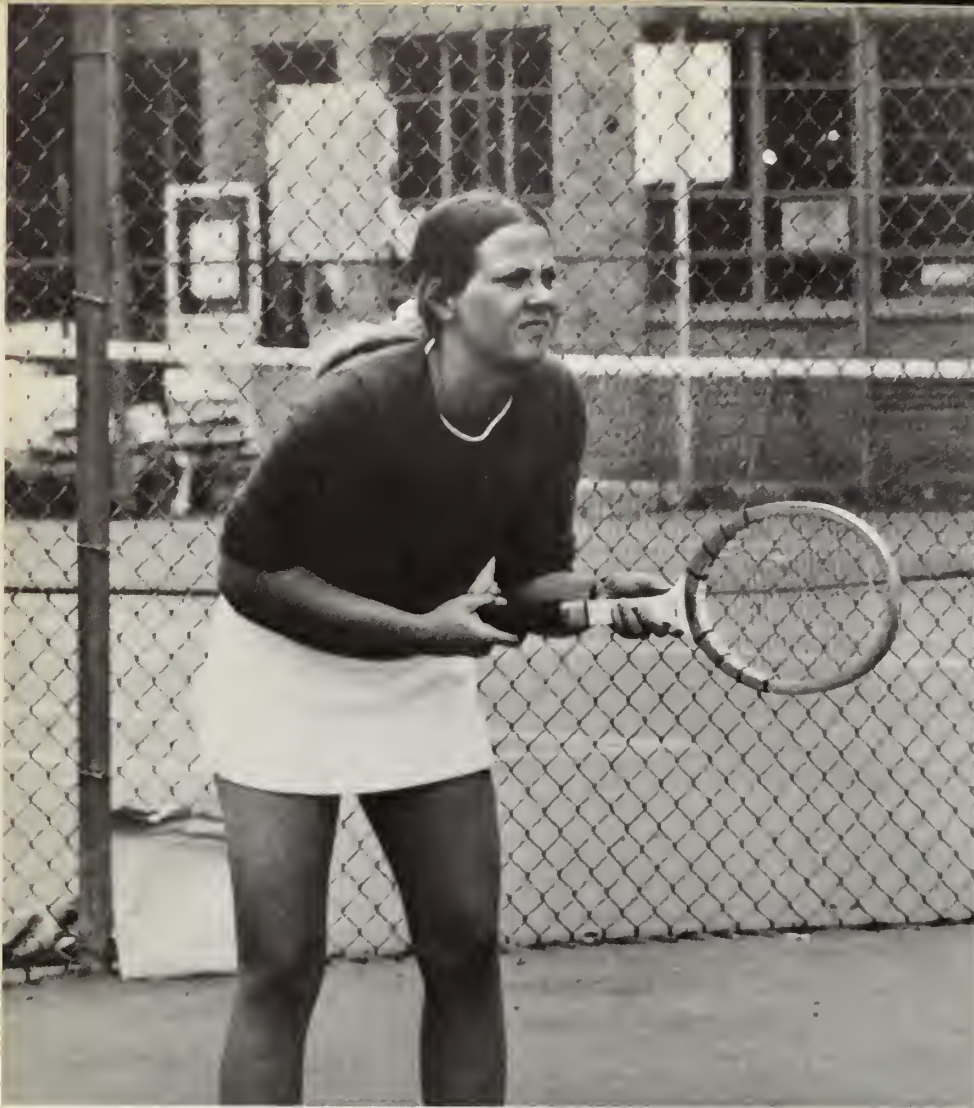

Coach Longley is hoping for another conference title next year with the outstanding ability of this team's underclassmen.





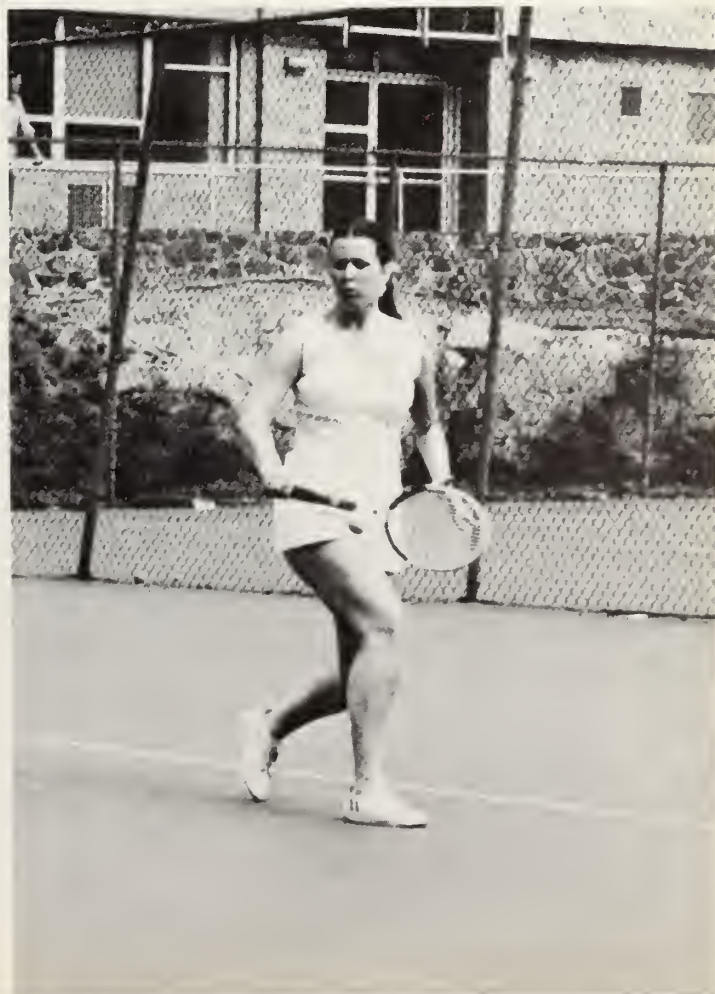
Tennis

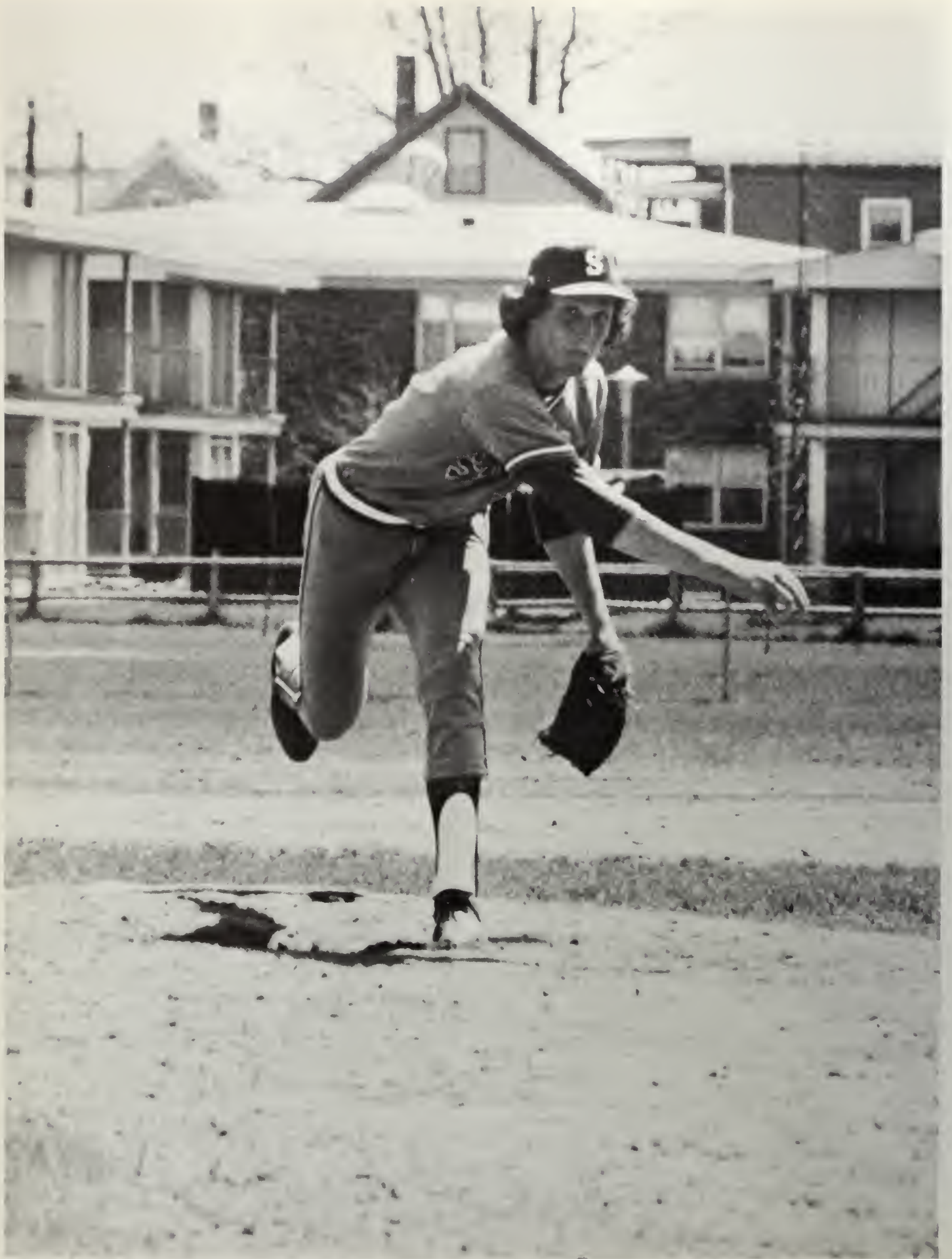




Baseball

The Mass. State College Athletic Conference was won by SSC for the third year. In addition to this NCAA tournament win, two individuals qualified for the ECAC finals. Jim Lane, a freshman, finished third individually, and Bob Dyer, a sophomore, scored in the top ten qualifiers.

The spring season was equally impressive with one exception, a loss to SMU, leaving a record of 15 wins and 1 loss.

The team, once again for the sixth straight year, was invited to represent District I in the NCAA College Division Championships, this year held in Tampa, Florida. Salem finished 18th out of 31 teams!





Track





With a record of 15 wins and 6 losses, the men's track team had an outstanding season. The trip to Florida in the pre-season helped the team to get an early start on practice, aiding their performance during the season. Seniors who served a valuable place on the team were Scott Gillis, javelin and hammer, Bob Murphy, hammer and discus, Dick Krisko, 440 intermediate hurdles, and Manny DeCruz, high jump.
