Always consider the RATING in connection with the name; otherwise you will do injustice to the individual, and injustice to the Register. If it was the purpose to present a list of intentional dead beats, simply, there would be no rating—only a roll of names. The field of the Register is broader; it reports all classes of undesirable subjects for credit, those who are “good” but generally so slow that credit given them at a low margin above cost will be apt to net an actual loss after deducting interest charges, and perhaps the expense of collecting; those who, though honest, are too poor, etc., etc.
