checked are the courses I am taking  
now - to be supplemented by a course  
in Civilian Air Regulation - although I  
don't know where they are going to  
put it in our day. This list gives you  
an opportunity to see some of the  
classes that are being taught here -

We are divided into different  
groups with the letter denoting our  
class. As you can see I am in 1C  
which means I will be here for  
two more months moving out on  
we about July 15<sup>th</sup>, class 1B stay here  
three more months, 1A, four months  
class 1D has moved out this past  
week - so we are all moved up a

flight - but the length of our stay remain  
the same.

We expect a new group of  
"god jets" in tonight - & they will move  
in as flight 14 - they will stay here  
five months - each month a new  
class comes in as an old group moves  
out - the new group remain as under-  
classmen for one month.

As you probably know by  
now - I will not be able to make  
graduation - while I am very disappointed -  
I know that my training here is far  
too valuable to allow them to give  
me a furlough - while I won't be  
seeing you all graduation - still see  
be there in feeling - hope all my  
classmates will be able to march  
that long last mile -
